Lesson #13: "Your Special Day with God"

1: WHAT IS THE SIGN OF GOD'S CREATORSHIP?

Exodus 31:16-17: "Wherefore the children of Israel shall keep the Sabbath. to observe the Sabbath throughout their generations for acovenant. It is a sign between Me and the children of Israel for ever: for in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, and on the seventh day He rested, and was refreshed."
2: WAS THE SABBATH MADE BEFORE MAN SINNED?
1. Genesis 2:2-3: "On the day God ended His work which He had made; and He rested on the seventh day from all His work which He had made. And God the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it He had rested from all His work which God created and made."
2. Exodus 20:10, 11: "The seventh day is the of the Lord thy God In six days the Lord made heaven and earth and rested the seventh day: wherefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it".
3: WAS THE SABBATH SIGN TO BE FOR ALL MEN FOR ALL TIME?
1. Mark 2:27: "The Sabbath was made for, and not man for the Sabbath."
2. Genesis 26:5: "Abraham obeyed My voice, and kept My charge, My, My statutes, and My laws."
Psalm 105:43, 45: "He brought forth His people with joy and His chosen with gladness that they might observe His statutes, and keep His"
3. Isaiah 58:13-14: "If thou turn away thy foot from the Sabbath, from doing thy pleasure on My holy day; and call the Sabbath a delight. the holy of the Lord, honourable; and shalt honour Him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking thine own words: then shalt thou delight thyself in the Lord; and I will cause thee to ride upon the high places of the earth, and feed thee with the heritage of Jacob thy father: for the of the Lord hath spoken it"
4. Jeremiah 17:21-22: "Thus saith the LORD; Take heed to yourselves, and bear no burden on the sabbath day, nor bring it in by the gates of Jerusalem; 22 Neither carry forth a burden out of your houses on the sabbath day, neither do ye any, but hallow ye the sabbath day, as I commanded your fathers."

5. Luke 4:16: "He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up: and as His was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up for
to read."
John 15:10: "If ye keep My commandments, ye shallin My love; even as I have kept My Father's commandments, and abide in His love."
Luke 23:55-56: "The women also, which came with Him from Galilee, followed after, and beheld the sepulchre, and how His body was laid. And they returned, and prepared spices and ointments; and rested the Sabbath dayto the commandment."
Matthew 24:20: "Pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on theday."
6. Acts 13:14, 42, 14 But when they departed from Perga, they came to Antioch in Pisidia, and went into the synagogue on the day, and sat down. 42 And when the Jews were gone out of the synagogue, the Gentiles besought that these words might be to them the next sabbath.
7. Isaiah 66:22-23: "As the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before Me, saith the Lord, so shall your seed and your name remain. And it shall come to pass, that from one new moon to another, and from one Sabbath to another; shall all flesh come to before Me. Saith the Lord."
